



# Participation Policy

RDV OACIQ 2026

## Participation conditions | Licence status

---

Participation in the RDV OACIQ 2026 event is restricted to individuals holding a licence issued by the OACIQ at the time of the event, unless otherwise specified for certain specifically identified activities.

It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that their licence is valid and in good standing at the time of registration and on the day of the event. The organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to the event or to withdraw eligibility for continuing education units (CEUs) from any person whose licence status does not meet the applicable requirements.

The **licence statuses eligible** for participation in the RDV OACIQ are the following:

- **Valid** – complete right to practise
- **Suspended** – right to practise temporarily suspended
- **Revoked (less than 12 months)** – licence withdrawn, no longer authorized to practise
- **Revoked with acquired rights** – possibility of returning to practice within a specified period
- **Licence with conditions or restrictions** – practice permitted subject to certain limits or obligations

Individuals working for an educational institution, whether or not they hold a real estate brokerage licence, may attend the RDV by paying the applicable registration fee via the Professional Development Portal (PDP).

## Obtaining continuing education units (CEUs)

---

- The awarding of CEUs is conditional upon mandatory attendance throughout the duration of the eligible activities scheduled as part of the event.
- Attendance-tracking mechanisms may be implemented, including check-in systems or any other electronic means deemed appropriate by the organizer.
- Any departure before the end of an activity, partial absence, or failure to comply with attendance rules will automatically result in the non-awarding of CEUs, in whole or in part, with no possibility of a refund or retake.
- No exceptions will be made, except in cases of duly documented force majeure, at the organizer's sole discretion.
- The CEUs will be entered into the participant's record within 10 business days of the event.
- The 6 CEUs earned by attending the RDV OACIQ event count as part of the "elective" category.

## Food and beverage services

---

- Meals, snacks, or refreshments may be provided, depending on the format of the event.
- At the time of registration, participants are responsible for declaring any allergies, food intolerances, or specific dietary restrictions. Although reasonable measures are taken, the organizer cannot guarantee the complete absence of allergens.
- In accordance with the Palais des congrès policy, participants are strictly prohibited from bringing their own food or beverages onto the event premises. This rule applies to all areas accessible to participants.

The organizer accepts no liability for any reaction or discomfort that may result from the consumption of food or beverages provided during the event.

## Use and protection of personal information

---

- By registering for and attending the RDV OACIQ 2026 event, participants consent to the collection, use, and retention of their personal information, including their name, contact details, licence number, and attendance data.

This information is used exclusively for the following purposes:

- Registration management
  - Attendance monitoring
  - Awarding of CEUs
  - Communications before, during and after the event
- Photographs and audio or video recordings may be taken during the event. By attending, participants consent to the use of their image for institutional, promotional, or archival purposes, unless written notice to the contrary is provided to the organizer before the event.
  - Personal information is handled in accordance with the applicable legislation governing the protection of personal information in Québec.

## Parking and travel

---

- Parking is available at the Palais des congrès, subject to the establishment's terms, availability, and current rates.
- Parking fees are entirely the responsibility of participants, and parking spaces cannot be guaranteed.
- The organizer accepts no liability for any tickets, damage, theft, or loss that may occur in the parking areas, nor for delays caused by traffic, congestion, or the **availability** of parking spaces.
- Participants are strongly advised to arrive early to comply with the official event schedule and mandatory attendance requirements.

## Accommodation

---

- Several hotels are located near the Palais des congrès, all within walking distance or a short travel distance.
- Participants are fully responsible for booking their own accommodation, covering all related costs, and complying with the policies of their chosen establishment.
- The organizer does not guarantee room availability, rates, or the terms and conditions for changes or cancellations.
- Any hotel information or recommendations provided by the organizer are for informational purposes only and do not constitute an official commitment or partnership, unless otherwise stated.

## Behaviour and compliance with the rules

---

- Participants must behave in a professional and respectful manner at all times to support the smooth running of the event.
- Any behaviour deemed inappropriate, disruptive, or contrary to the established rules may result in the participant's immediate expulsion, without refund, as well as the loss of entitlement to CEUs.

## Acceptance of the policy

---

- Registering for and participating in the RDV OACIQ 2026 event constitute full, voluntary, and informed acceptance of this participation policy.
